Cancellation & Refunds

If you need to cancel a Summer Farm Adventure for any reason, please contact us as soon as possible at education@oxbow.org or call (425) 788-1134 x 3. **Our refund policy is as follows:**

Cancellations made 15 or more days prior to your scheduled Summer Farm Adventure, Oxbow will retain \$75 for administration and processing fees. All refunds will be issued within 7-14 business days of the cancellation.

Cancellations made 14 days or less prior to your scheduled Summer Farm Adventure will not be refunded.

Acts of Mother Nature

In the past, we've enjoyed spending summer days outside rain and shine, only canceling events in rare instances of lightning. With the increased threat of summer wildfire smoke in Western Washington, it is necessary to have an updated plan in place to ensure the safety of our campers and staff.

Throughout the summer months, Oxbow Staff will monitor the [Washington Department of Ecology](#) website for updates on air quality. **If threat levels at our nearest monitoring sites in North Bend and Bellevue read "Unhealthy" or worse, or if our specific Snoqualmie Valley site conditions are deemed unsafe by our Education Program Manager, we will reach out to all registrants, first via email then via phone call, by 7:30AM to cancel programs for the day.**

Your program will be reimbursed at 50% of your program total cost. These conditions pose a huge threat to outdoor recreation, agriculture, and environmental organizations, and we are grateful for your support and understanding.
