



CSA Pick-up Protocol – on-farm at Oxbow

Thank you for joining us for Oxbow's Spring CSA. We're thrilled to be planning for your first Share! Below are some important details to help facilitate a safe, smooth pickup.

Choosing your Weekly Share

Oxbow will email all Shareholders every Friday with a link to reserve your weekly box selection. All box reservations must be made by midnight every Sunday. If we don't hear from you, we'll make your box selection for you! Make sure you add farmers@oxbow.org to your email address book to be sure you receive our communications.

Pick-up Time and Day

Pickup is every Wednesday from 3pm-7pm, May 13th to June 17th. Please do not come outside of the designated pick-up window – our staff will be out in the fields and will not be available to assist you.

Directions



Please use Oxbow's Public Entrance off Hwy 203 at 268th Ave NE, Carnation, 98104, ½ mile south of the 124th roundabout. Look for the orange-bordered Oxbow sign marking the corner of 268th Ave. You'll follow a dirt farm road for a stretch and will pass several private driveways. Please drive SLOWLY at 10mph and watch for kids & farm animals. When you get to the end of the road, turn LEFT at the Oxbow sign.

Pick-up Information

Park in the grass near the Farm Stand – located in a white tent at the end of the gravel driveway. We ask that you either wait in your car if another Shareholder is picking up, or stand at least six feet away from the Farm Stand. We will have spots marked out in front of the Farm Stand to help with social distancing while you wait for your weekly box of farm goods!

At this time Oxbow's trails, fields, and U-pick areas are closed. Please stay within the designated parking lot or in front of the Farm Stand. We look forward to opening back up to the public when it's safe to do so, and we'll be sure to let you know when you can come visit the rest of the farm!
