



**Safe Events Plan**  
*May 24, 2021 Update*

Oxbow is committed to implementing policies informed by the regulations and recommendations put forth by relevant government agencies. This is a working document and has been updated to reflect changes in directives and introduce new recommended practices as they become available.

**Wearing masks, staying six-feet apart, and washing hands frequently are the key principles underlying Oxbow's Safety Procedures.**

**Health Screening At Entry**

At entry, all visitors must answer these Health Screening questions:

- 1. Have you had close contact with or cared for someone diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last 14 days?**
- 2. Are you experiencing any of the following symptoms?**

- Fever
- Dry cough
- Tiredness
- Aches and pains
- Sore throat
- Diarrhea
- Conjunctivitis
- Headache
- Loss of taste or smell
- Rash or discoloration of fingers or toes
- Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
- Chest pain or pressure

If either question is answered **YES**, entry is not possible.

**Continuation of Mask Wearing**

Regardless of vaccination status, all visitors to Oxbow must remain masked while on site until further notice. Oxbow will provide visitors with disposable masks if necessary.

Please be sure to wear a mask while you are in a restroom or honey bucket. Take care to wash or sanitize hands after removing your mask or touching your face.
